



QUICK FACTS

Owners	Tom and Kerry Eddy. Tom graduated from U.C. Davis in 1974 with a degree in winemaking. Kerry, also a UCD grad, has a background in wine wholesale, restaurant and wine media.
Winemaker	As a young winemaker in the '70's, and reluctant to be a 'prisoner of the culture', Tom eschewed the small guys and cut his winemaking teeth at such early luminaries as Wente Bros., Inglenook and Christian Brothers. This allowed him to parlay his sizeable experience into becoming, at the age of 29, the youngest winemaker and General Manager of a major California winery (Souverain). Tom's steady, purposeful rise in the industry eventually led to him being recently heralded as one of the top eleven California winemakers responsible for the dramatic rise in California wine quality in the last 30 years. Tom went on his own in 1989 but continues to be a much sought after national and international consultant while continuing to concentrate his talents on producing elegant, complex Tom Eddy Napa Valley Cabernets.
Philosophy	Tom's approach to winemaking is to create the most elegant wines from the finest hillside grapes. Simple as that.
Winery	Located on twenty-two total acres, 1000 feet above the Napa Valley, the new winery's pre-construction site work has been completed. The next phase includes the completion of the winery road and cave installation. The Eddy winery will incorporate lumber milled on-site and will feature a gravity flow design with crushing facilities above ground and barrel storage in caves below the winery.
Vineyards	Selected, progressive growers from Diamond Mountain, Oakville Bench, Atlas Peak and Coombsville District. Grapes are hand-sorted, crushed and barreled separately then precisely blended immediately before bottling to optimize balance, complexity and nuance.
Wines	Up to 3,000 six packs of Tom Eddy Cabernet Sauvignon annually. Also small lots of Elodian Cab & Sauvignon Blanc, as well as a limited selection of Oregon Pinot Noir, New Zealand SB, Zin Port and Tom Eddy VSR.
Cooperage	Primarily Sylvain, Fouquet, Saury, and Vicard Prestige barrels.
Packaging	Award-winning, hand-torn (and applied by hand) label inspired by the rocky soils and ridgelines of hillside Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards. The VSR Cabernet is bottled in French glass inspired by a 19 th Century design. VSR carries a ceramic seal designed by Kerry.
