HARVEST NOTES:

2004 was an ideal growing year for Napa Cabernet Sauvignon. A virtually perfect amount of rainfall coupled with a long ripening period lead to some very high quality and very flavorful fruit. Two separate heat waves late in the season brought the small crop to maturity quickly and most winemakers ended up harvesting all their fruit within a four week period.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2004 Elodian Cabernet Sauvignon is a rich and intensely flavorful wine. Blackberry, cherry, cassis and other dark fruits intermingle with spicy cedar aromas that immediately draw you in to the complexity and richness that permeate this wine. The dark fruit flavors are enriched with subtle coffee and chocolate that seem to coat your mouth with flavors that linger on the palate. The big structure and mouth-feel of this wine create a wonderful texture for you to enjoy as you relish in the powerful flavors of this hedonistic offering. Because of its great structure, this wine tastes great now and will age very well in your cellar for a decade or more...if, of course, you can stand to wait that long to enjoy it!
